

You will need:


- · 2 spray bottles
- · stone coloured paper or card
- · red and yellow poster paints
- water



- Set up your workspace by covering any surfaces to protect them from damage.
- 2. Mix the yellow paint with some water in a spray bottle. The amount of water used depends on how vivid you would like the colour to be.



- 4. Place your hand in the centre of the paper.
- Spray plenty of yellow paint around it. Make sure you spray enough to create a clear, sharp shape of your hand.



- 7. Check you are happy with the blend of colours before carefully lifting your hand. Be careful not to smudge the paint as you lift your hand.
- 8. Wash your hands thoroughly, using soap and water.
