










## Homework Grid Y3 Spring 1 2023

This piece of cave art is based on a Stone Age painting found in Argentina. The original artist probably blew paint through a reed or even spat the paint onto the wall! We don't recommend you try this!



#### You will need:

- 2 spray bottles
- stone coloured paper or card
- red and yellow poster paints
- water



#### Instructions:

1. Set up your workspace by covering any surfaces to protect them from damage.
2. Mix the yellow paint with some water in a spray bottle. The amount of water used depends on how vivid you would like the colour to be.



3. Repeat using red paint and water.

4. Place your hand in the centre of the paper.

5. Spray plenty of yellow paint around it. Make sure you spray enough to create a clear, sharp shape of your hand.



6. Leaving your hand in exactly the same position, spray on the red paint from the other bottle.

7. Check you are happy with the blend of colours before carefully lifting your hand. Be careful not to smudge the paint as you lift your hand.

8. Wash your hands thoroughly, using soap and water.
