We will present information in many different ways including, writing reports, creating stories and writing instructions. As Mathematicians we will: Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (–) and equals (=) signs. Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words. Given a number, identify <b>one more</b> and <b>one less</b> . Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least		As Artists we will: Teach how to use a sketch book in trialling sketches and adding to their portrait before producing their final piece. Explore the information on Van Gogh and Pablo Picasso. Who are they and where they from. Learn about what techniques did artists use to produce portraits.	As Designers we will: N/A this half term	As Computer Engineers we will: Learn to use a keyboard and be able to access various sites such as bug club using their passwords.
