In here you'll find activities taking place across the city in the school holidays – and if your child has a Passport to Learning, they'll be able to earn CU credits for taking part in all of them! You can buy a Passport to Learning (£3.50) from any Sheffield Library (if you attend a Sheffield School or are a member of our Home Education scheme). Some of the activities are FREE while some will need to be paid for, and some require booking in advance.

During 2020 and 2021, we published daily CU Home Learning Challenges and we reached **98** of them by the end of the school year! As they were so successful, we continued publishing challenges during the school holidays and the great news is that they're all still available for you to download and complete, so have a look for the links to access them on the next page. There is information on how you can claim CU credits for completing these challenges if you normally attend a Sheffield school and have a Passport to Learning.

ATTEND A SHEFFIELD SCHOOL (or be part of our Home Education scheme): you'll need to have a CU Passport to Learning, then click this link - https://bit.ly/claimSCUcreditsbeyondSheffield ATTEND A CU SCHOOL IN ANOTHER AREA: Contact your local CU centre or school for the CU Activity Stamp Code to enter into CU online to claim your credit/s (Sheffield families please note: Sheffield CU does NOT yet use CU Online)



How to buy a CU Passport to Learning!

Buy one from your local Sheffield library - £3.50 each



Visit <u>www.sheffield.gov.uk/libraries</u> to find details of your nearest library and their opening hours



We recommend giving them a call to check they have Passports to Learning in stock before making a special journey



Pop along, buy your CU Passport to Learning, then a parent/carer must sign the consent sticker inside



Before you leave, why not ask Library staff about the activities they run? You can earn CU credits at them!

The Sheffield Christmas Trail...Brearley Bear and the Reindeer Round-up runs from 26 November – 24 December. Brearley's Christmas HQ (Surrey Street, next to the Winter Garden) will be open daily from 10am to 5pm Monday-Saturday (7pm Thursdays) and 10am to 4pm Sundays. It will be open 10am to 4pm on Christmas Eve. (Please note it will be closed on Monday, 5 December from 12 noon.)

Join us for an immersive family experience set in the magical festive setting of Santa's Study. Enter our enchanted forest to reveal a fun, playful space with lots of funny details to be discovered when you enter Santa's warm and cosy study.






