Year 1 Phonics Screening




In the Summer term in June each child is required to take Year 1 Phonics Screening which involves asking the children to read number of words to their teacher.


It is done in a quiet space where one child goes to be assessed on their reading (about 10 - 15 minutes). Throughout the year we will be tracking your child's progress in Phonics and we will support them by giving them the necessary resources and teaching they may need to be successful.

As a school, we follow the Systematic Synthetic Phonics Scheme from Twinkl. Your child will be bringing home decodable texts linked to the Twinkl scheme where they will practise blending to read words. (More information about Twinkl phonics and the resources we use are on the class pages of the website)




You will also hear these terms from your child.





An example of 'Pseudo' words. There will be 20 Pseudo words to read in the phonics screening check.




An example of 'real' words. There will be 20 real words in the phonics screening check.

There are a number of ways to help your child:

- Read with your child for around 10 minutes everyday.
- Write the title of the book in their Reading Record and sign it.
- O Listen to them read the Guided Reading book.
- Ask them to sound talk unfamiliar words.
- Practice spellings everyday, some words have the phonemes we have been learning that week.
