Term: Autumn 2	Theme: The Great Fire of London	
Key Questions: Why did London burn? How can we change the properties of materials?	Text: Vlad and the Great Fire of London by Kate Cunningham	
In writing, we will: Write to inform by recounting a real event. We will be recounting the Great Fire of London in the form of a diary. In Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG), we will: Continue to punctuate our sentences correctly. We will look at statements, questions, commands and exclamations.	In Design and Technology, we will: Look at creating structures, using our woodcutting skills. Our focus will be creating houses like those during the Great Fire of London.	In History, we will: Learn about the Great Fire of London as an event beyond living memory that is significant nationally. We will learn why the events occured and what happened as a result.
In Maths, we will: Learn how to add and subtract two 2-digit numbers on a number line. Learn how to effectively multiple and divide.	In Computing, we will: Create media using digital photography.	In Music, we will: We will be learning songs for our Nativity performance.
In Science, we will: Identify and compare different materials and say how different materials are suitable for different uses and how the properties of materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting or stretching.	In Physical Education (PE), we will: Indoor: Practise skills needed in invasion games. Outdoor: Practise ball skills including throwing and catching.
