Sheffield Theatres Youth Theatre 8 – 12s

STYT is an acting and theatre making project for young people aged 8-12 (school years 4 - 7).

Young people who take part will learn performance skills, explore their creativity and perform in shows across Sheffield Theatres stages, which includes the Crucible, Lyceum and Montgomery.

Your child has been recommended to STYT as we think they would thrive in the youth theatre.

What to Expect

As well as being great for creativity, we know that being part of a youth theatre can support young people's overall wellbeing. For a young person, being part of a youth theatre can:

- Improve confidence
- Create new friendships
- Improve social skills
- Provide a sense of belonging
- Expand aspirations

The sessions are fun and engaging, encouraging young people to try new things within a safe environment. The project is led by a professional theatre director and there is support from a qualified Youth Worker each week.

Cost, Food and Travel

The sessions are free, there is no cost to attend.

When young people arrive, they will be given a free hot meal.

Travel is also covered, we can either book your young person a taxi from home to attend the session or provide bus money for them to travel by themselves.

The sessions happen each week on a Tuesday evening from 4pm – 6pm over 10 weeks. The term dates are as follows (excluding Tue 27 May for half term):
